Proposal for HD417 limited entry Deer Permits (copied from <u>fwp.mt.gov</u> website)

*For the upcoming 2024-25 hunting season in hunting districts (HDs) 410, 411, 412, 417, 419, and 426, it is proposed to: • Change the mule deer general license regulation in HDs 410 and 417 from "Antlered Buck Only" (AB) to limited-entry (LE) permits for both 6-week archery and 5-week general seasons (quota 100, quota range 25-500);

My name is Matt Wickens and I've owned Dog Creek Outfitters in the 417 area for over 20 years. As an outfitter my livelihood depends on the success and abundance of wildlife in our area and I see no need to include the northwestern portion of 417 into a limited deer permit. Outside of the fact that we have a strong deer population in our localized area, if this proposal goes through I will be out of business within a year as about 75% of our income is derived from mule deer hunting. I completely understand the need for limited deer permits on land east of the Stafford Ferry Road but no change in permitting is necessary on land west of the Stafford Ferry Road.

Quick Overview of HD 417

417 is a large hunting district with very diverse terrain and needs, and should be managed as such.

The **eastern** portion of the unit contains vast areas of accessible public land with limited agriculture (i.e. farmland/homesteads), deer numbers in the eastern portion have plummeted to dangerously low levels primarily due to drought, harsh winters, no supplemental feed (haystacks, shelterbelts, ect.), unlimited public access which has resulted in overuse and the encroachment of elk into what was historically mule deer range.

The **northwestern** portion of unit 417 is very different from the east. The northwestern portion is primarily private land and land-locked public with a higher concentration of farm fields, homesteads, and limited public access. The deer population in the northwestern portion of 417 is strong. It's not uncommon to see 75-100 deer a day while we are consistently harvesting older age class deer.

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Simple Solution

Two years ago the northwestern boundary of HD417 was changed, moving the northwestern boundary from the Stafford Ferry Road further west to the PN Bridge Road. I would simply propose to revert back to the original boundaries as it was for many many years. Switching the northwestern boundary back to its original location of the Stafford Ferry Road would not only save the business I have been building for the last 22 years, it is also a commonsense point of division that separates two very different landscapes with different needs.

MOGA has been working diligently with several other organizations and the Department to forward proposals and comments regarding season setting. Unfortunately, there is not a vehicle for members of the public to get ideas before the community directly for consideration and comment. Therefore, we need to rely on individual Commission members to request an item be added to the Commission meeting agenda. Thank you for considering this request.

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1. ESTABLISH Elk QUOTAS FOR HD 700-20 & 700-21.

I am requesting you use the authority granted to you and request an Increase either-sex season elk quotas for HD 700-20 (rifle) from 200 to 250 and HD 700-21 (archery) from 660 to 800 and by so doing reinstate the Commission approved levels from February 2022. I have attached a copy of the specific proposal and supporting material.

2. Restrict Mule Deer Doe Harvest to Private Land in R7

I am also requesting that a proposal that restricts mule deer doe harvest in R7 to private land. Commissioner Lane (R7) is reluctant to submit it under his name, however, I think he agrees it is a worthy enterprise to release it for public reaction and comment. I have attached a copy of the specific proposal and supporting material.

As you know, the process is that a Commissioner may request this item be added to the December 14 agenda. By doing so it will allow the public to see and comment on this proposal. Further, your request does not imply support or consent for the proposal. We would want the public comment to inform your position.

Thank you for your willingness to assist in this matter and let me know if you require anything further.
