We encourage the use of legally issued permits, tags, and/or licenses for the hunting of wild mountain sheep, goats and other North American species. We strive to inform and educate people of the world about wild mountain sheep and goats and other North American big game and also to use financial resources to benefit, directly or indirectly, wild mountain sheep and goats and other North American big game.

Since 2005, Grand Slam Club/Ovis has organized annual conventions in which numerous hunting tags have be auctioned to attendees, along with online and phone bidders, in order to promote and raise monies for state agencies and various hunting and conservation organizations.

If a tag(s) were allotted to GSCO, we would use both printed and online media in order to market the information about such tags along with information about proceeds going to conservation efforts in the State of Montana.

GSCO would donate 100% of the high bid for any sheep tag received, or retain 10% of the total sale of any other tags, with the remaining 90% going to The Licensing Bureau of Montana Fish, Wildlife and Parks.
