Proposed Amendment: I move the Fish and Wildlife Commission adopt the following amendment to the Proposed 2026 Mountain Lion Region 2 Quotas:

Rationale and Background: In discussions with Region 2 residents, there are concerns with current quotas in Region 2 and the broad brush increase that was applied to quotas a few years ago. An analysis of quotas, harvest and ungulate objectives was applied on an LMU level to develop the proposed quotas. This proposal decreases the total Region 2 quota by 9 lions from 210 to 201 (4.3% decrease). Specific to lion sex, the proposal increases the male quota by 3, from 108 to 111 and decreases females from 77 to 70 (9.1% decrease). LMU 299 quotas is not included in the sex specific numbers referenced, but was referenced in the overall quota reduction. LMU 299 is proposed to decrease from 25 to 20 lions.

Department Response:

The department does not anticipate any substantive biological effects to the mountain lion population as a result of this amendment.
