

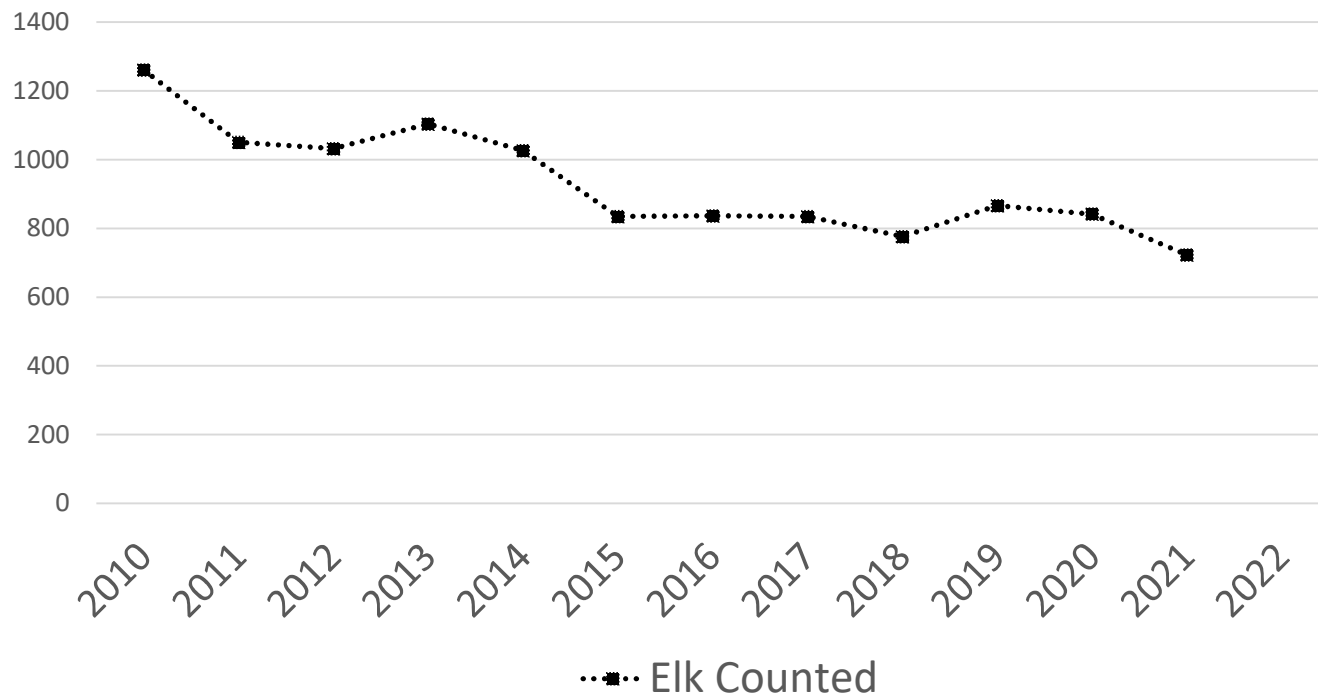
HD 321

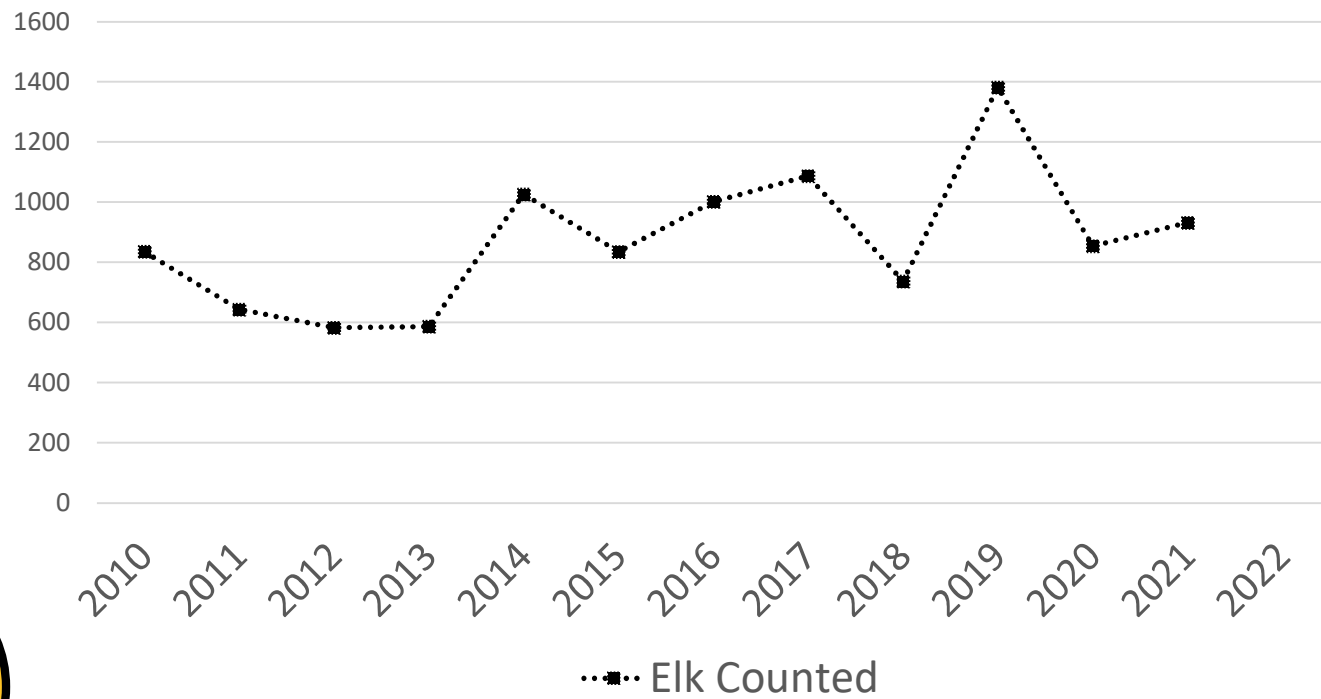
Former HD 321
