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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report summarizes weed management expenditures and accomplishments across all three divisions of Montana Fish, Wildlife and Parks (FWP) during Fiscal Year 2022 (FY22), which includes July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

FWP directly manages 511,092 acres across 497 distinct sites throughout the state and is responsible for noxious weed management on most of these areas. Estimated infested acres for all FWP lands for FY22 were 51,828, equaling approximately 10% infested. The acreages associated within each separate site type are as follows:

- Fishing Access Sites (FAS) comprise approximately 17,199 acres in fee title and leased lands across 355 sites. Estimated noxious weed infested acres for these lands were 2,728, equaling approximately 16% infested in FY22. Utilizing chemical, mechanical, biological control and revegetation treatment methods the division treated 1,158 acres, equaling approximately 42% of infested acres treated for the fiscal year.
- Wildlife Management Areas (WMA) comprise approximately 451,313 acres in fee title and leased lands across 79 sites. Estimated noxious weed infested acres for these lands were 44,162, equaling approximately 10% infested in FY22. Utilizing chemical, mechanical, biological control and revegetation treatment methods the division treated 10,565 acres, equaling approximately 24% of infested acres treated for the fiscal year.
- State Parks (SP) comprise approximately 42,470 acres in fee title and leased lands across 58 sites. Estimated noxious weed infested acres for these lands were 4,901, equaling approximately 12% infested in FY22. Utilizing chemical, mechanical, biological control and revegetation treatment methods the division treated 1,559 acres, equaling approximately 32% of infested acres treated for the fiscal year.

FWP continues to implement an integrated approach to controlling noxious weeds, as further described in FWP's statewide noxious weed plan (2008). That plan can be accessed and downloaded using the following web link: <https://fwp.mt.gov/conservation/habitat/noxious-weed-management>

Using an integrated approach to managing weeds, FWP staff prioritize efforts and select the most appropriate technique for addressing each noxious weed issue. For instance, infestations with a high likelihood of spreading to new locations are a priority for herbicide treatment, including parking lots, roads, and other high public use areas. New infestations in areas that previously lacked infestations or new noxious weed species are also a high priority for treatment and eradication, if possible. Vast infestations often require a different approach in collaboration with neighboring properties and county weed coordinators. Biocontrol in combination with herbicide applications at strategic locations are commonly used as a long-term solution where infestations are extensive, spanning multiple ownerships.

FWP also strives to take an ecological approach to weed management and prevention. This includes, where possible, avoiding ground disturbance, minimizing impacts from construction or other management activities, and being mindful to avoid impacting non-target vegetation when implementing weed control measures.

During FY22 FWP treated over 6,365 acres with herbicide equaling about 12% of reported estimated infested acres (Table 2) for the year. Combined with other types of treatments – mechanical and insect/biocontrol, the department treated approximately 13,314 acres, using the MT. Department of Agriculture’s estimate of 5 acres treated per biological control release. This represents an increase of 2,653 acres from the previous year equaling 26% of the total agency estimated infested acres. Noxious weed treatment expenditures were an estimated total of \$386,431 agency wide for the fiscal year (Table 3). Some personnel costs, training, education and outreach, and other aspects of weed management and prevention may not be included in these figures.

In addition to work on FWP lands, the department also provides funding toward weed management on private lands through the Block Management Program (Table 1). In 2022, FWP paid over \$ 343,833 to private landowners specifically to weed control.

FWP works closely with other government agencies including MT Department of Natural Resources and Conservation, U.S. Forest Service, MT Department of Agriculture, Bureau of Land Management and County Weed Coordinators along with private contractors and private landowners, to coordinate weed control efforts and to help contain the spread of noxious weeds throughout the state.

Fiscal Year 2022 saw the fifth round of applications for the Wildlife Habitat Improvement Program (WHIP) administered by FWP. WHIP was passed into law with the purpose of restoring ecologically important wildlife habitats by managing noxious weeds at watershed or landscape scales, typically involving collaborative efforts over multiple landownerships. The Act makes available up to \$2M annually in federal Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration (P-R) funds. In FY22 the WHIP Advisory Council voted to fund one submitted grant totaling \$660,122. These projects started receiving WHIP funding on August 1st, 2022:

- **The Bitterroot Big Three WHIP Project – 5 Year Project**
 - o 434,000 acres of priority wildlife habitat
 - o 34,708 acres receiving herbicide treatments and biological controls
 - o \$1,303,233 – Grant Funds (PR dollars); \$474,780 Matching Funds; Total Project: \$1,778,013.

The Data Tables Section of this report, which follows, summarizes weed infestation and control activities over most of the sites managed by FWP. This data is collected annually from the staff responsible for managing these sites. Data are organized by Administrative Region (Figure 1) and then by Division and County.
