You've never seen the Lewis & Clark Caverns like this!

We've arranged for a "Wild Cave" tour that takes us off the regular tour pathway. Get an up-close look at some of the cavern's most unique geology (speleothems). See delicate formations that took millions of years to form and learn about the history of this cave. Explore one of the most highly decorated limestone caverns in the Northwest.

Caving is a strenuous activity involving climbing, stooping and crawling. Please ensure your physical condition is adequate to participate in this activity. Tour runs from 4:00 to 7:00 pm. We'll be underground for about 2 hours.

Lewis & Clark Caverns Park is located 22 miles west of Three Forks on MT Highway 2 or 18 miles east of Whitehall on MT Highway 2.
