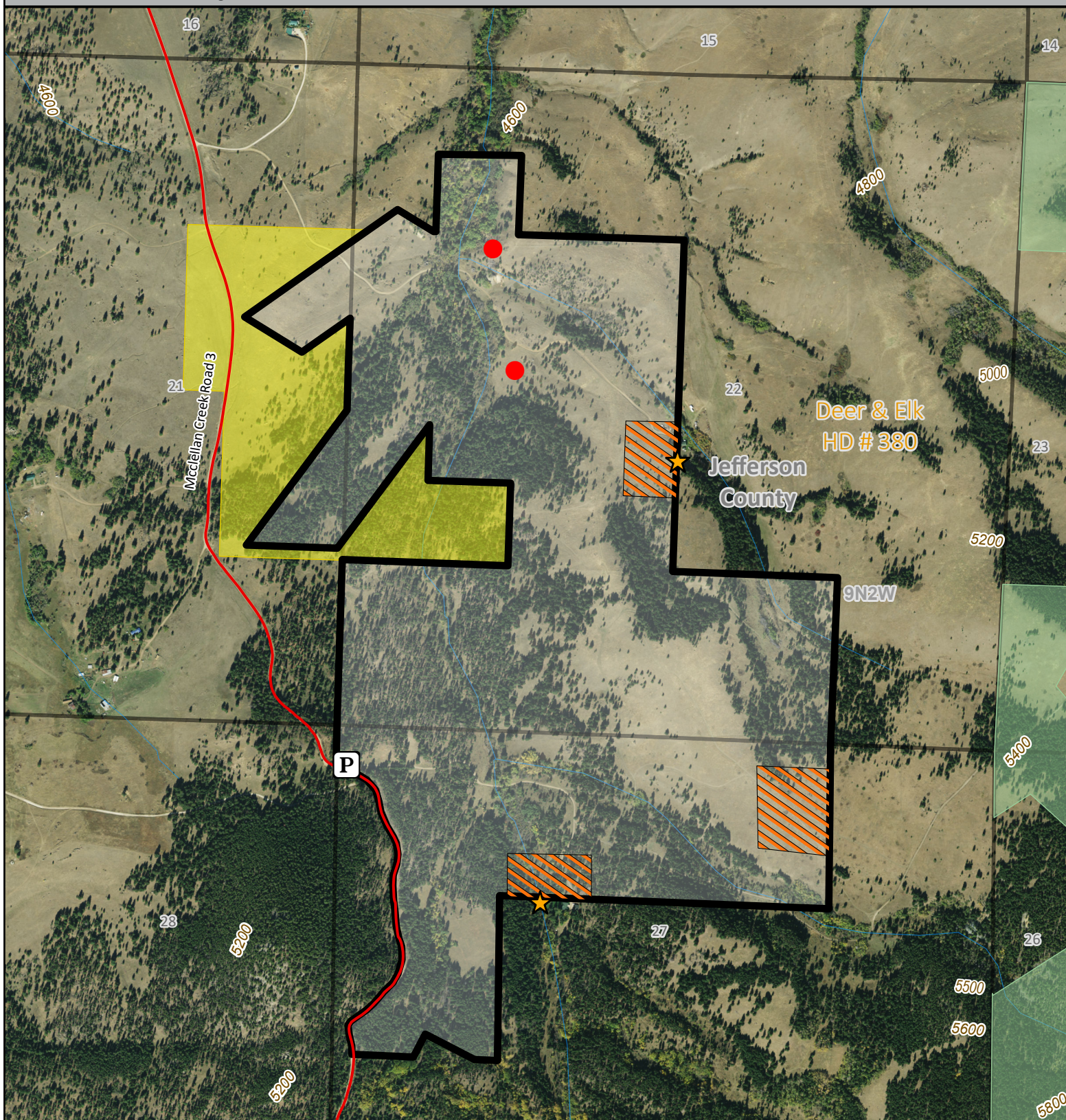

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. Reservation is required to hunt this BMA. Hunters must visit <https://www.surveyking.com/survey/Kokoruda26> to complete the permission hunt form.
2. Reservations can be made each Tuesday starting at 8am for the Thursday of the same week through Wednesday of the following week. All reservations are first-come, first-served. Reservations are not finalized until confirmed by FWP staff. BMA is limited to 2 hunting parties each day. Maximum of 4 hunters per party.
3. Hunters must display permission materials on the dash of their vehicle while on the property.

PARKING & ACCESS REQUIREMENTS

1. Hunters are required to park at the designated parking area or along county roads— be sure not to obstruct any traffic, homes, driveways or gates.
2. Retrieval of game is the responsibility of the hunter. For potential permission, call (513) 652-5865 or (406) 438-3575.

HOW TO GET THERE

- » From Hwy 287, turn South on McClellan Creek Rd
- » Follow for approximately 5.4 miles to the sign-in box located at 910 McClellan Creek Rd.

ADDITIONAL RULES

1. This BMA is walk-in only from designated roads as marked on map and signed.
2. Motorized vehicle off-road travel NOT allowed. STAY ON DESIGNATED ROUTES.
3. OnX and/or GPS devices should not be used to replace this map.
4. No varmint or antler shed hunting.
5. Be aware of neighboring houses, ranch buildings and equipment, and cattle.
6. Do not park vehicles in such a manner as to obstruct traffic. Do not block gates.
7. Camping and fires prohibited. No Smoking while on property.
8. Do not enter ranch buildings, corrals, or historical mine sites— STAY AWAY!
9. Neighboring landowners may drive certain roads on the property. They have permission to pass through. There are also neighboring homes close to the BMA boundary- please respect their property.
10. Remember, hunting on Block Management is a privilege made possible by the voluntary cooperation of the landowner. Please do your part to take care of this land as if it were your own.
11. Commercial outfitting is prohibited.
12. Fish & Wildlife Commission-approved hunting regulations apply. Hunters are required to possess the necessary hunting licenses for the species and hunting districts they are hunting.
