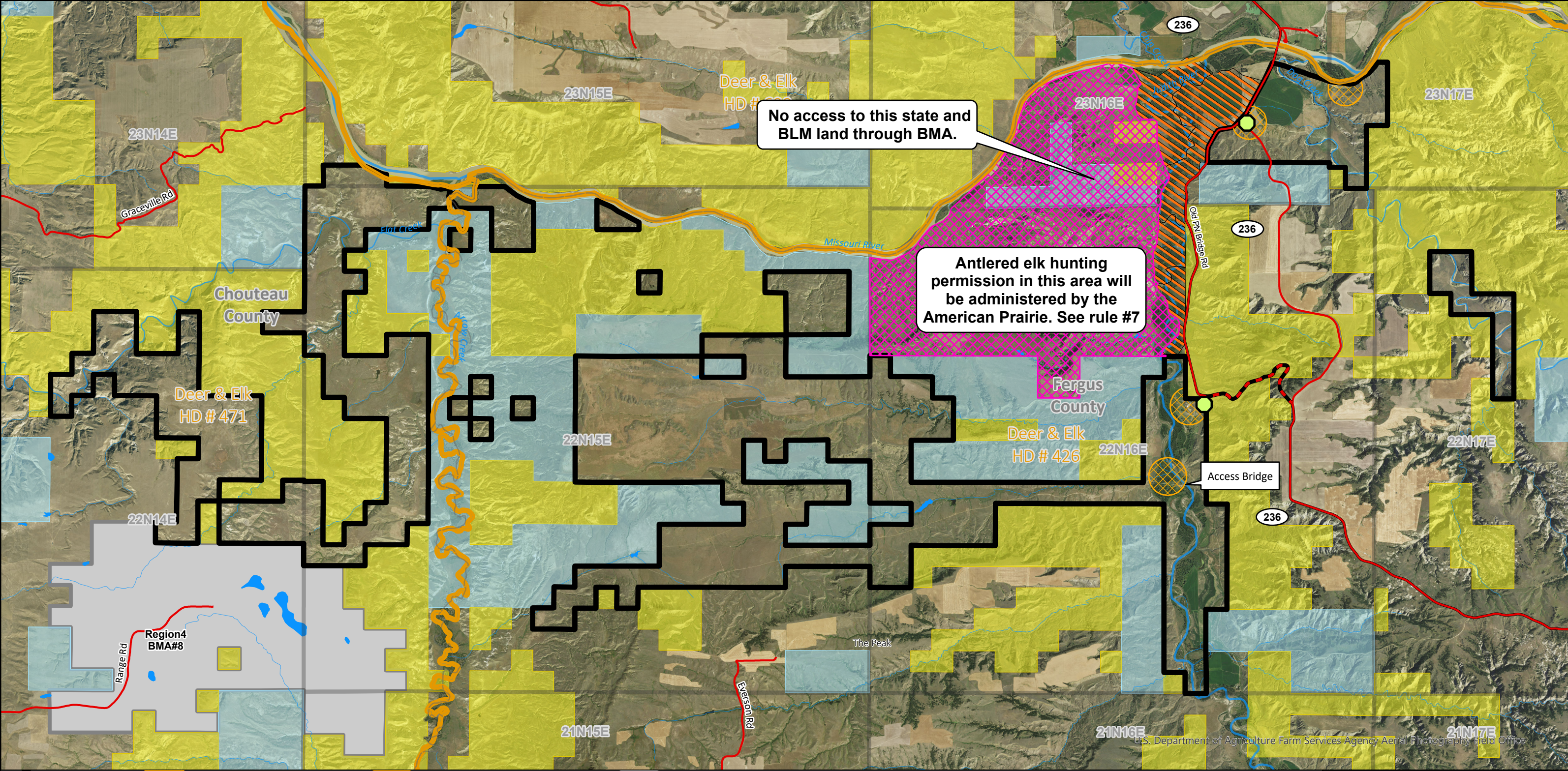


AP-PN Ranch Block Management Area #16

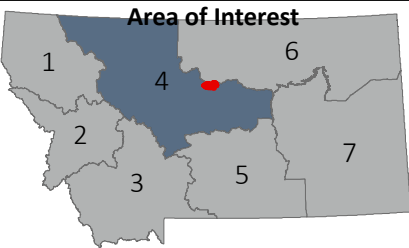

RESTRICTED SPECIES

The following species may be hunted on this BMA with valid licenses during legal hunting seasons unless otherwise restricted below:

Species	Dates Access Allowed
Elk	PROHIBITED (see permission requirements rule #7)
Mule Deer	Antlered Buck allowed with 426-50 permit during authorized season dates <u>only</u> DOE PROHIBITED
White-tailed Deer	Entire Season
Upland Birds	Entire Season SAGE GROUSE HUNTING PROHIBITED
Wild Turkey	Entire Season
Antelope	Entire Season
Nongame/Predators	PROHIBITED

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Reservations are REQUIRED.
- Reservations can be made on the Monday prior to the Thursday-Monday period you wish to hunt by calling (406) 422-6087 between 10:00 am and 11:00 am. **No same day reservations.**
- Hunter numbers are limited to 2 parties of 1-3 hunters.
- Hunters are limited to reserving 3 consecutive days.
- No boat-in access to private land, walk-in only.
- Hunters are reminded to cancel reservations if unable to hunt reserved days.
- Antlered Elk hunting permission will be administered by the American Prairie. Cow Elk hunting is PROHIBITED. Please contact American Prairie for permission requirements: <https://americanprairie.org/pn2026>**

SPRING TURKEY:

- Spring Turkey reservations can be made on the Monday prior to the Thursday–Sunday period you wish to hunt by calling (406) 454-5862 from 9:00 am - 11:00 am.**

» West on Main St.	0.4 mi
» North on MT-236	0.3 mi
» West and North on PN Bridge Rd. to BMA	21.4 mi

| <ol style="list-style-type: none">Hunting is prohibited within 1/4 mile of occupied dwellings. Hunting within safety zones on BMA map is prohibited.Motorized vehicle use is restricted to designated access routes, public roads, and parking areas as indicated on BMA Map.Use of all types of OHV, ATV's or similar vehicles are prohibited.E-bikes are prohibited except on designated motorized vehicle roads.Do not park vehicles in such a manner as to obstruct traffic. Do not block gates.Littering, visible latrine pits, and fires are prohibited.Camping Rules: Dispersed tent camping on private property allowed during <u>archery season only</u>. During general season, camping on private land is restricted to parking area <u>only</u>.Hunting and game retrieval allowed by walk-in or horseback only. No motorized game retrieval.Hunters using horses are required to use certified weed free hay 48 hours prior to entering BMA and while accessing BMA.Fish & Wildlife Commission-approved hunting regulations apply. Hunters are required to possess the necessary hunting licenses for the species and hunting districts they are hunting.<u>Commercial use is prohibited.</u> | |

STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- Block Management Area Rules do not apply to federal or DNRC lands that are legally accessible (via public roads, watercourses, or other legal means of access) unless specifically authorized by the applicable agency. Please, contact the respective federal and state agencies for more information.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Access during all other times and for any other activity requires landowner permission.
