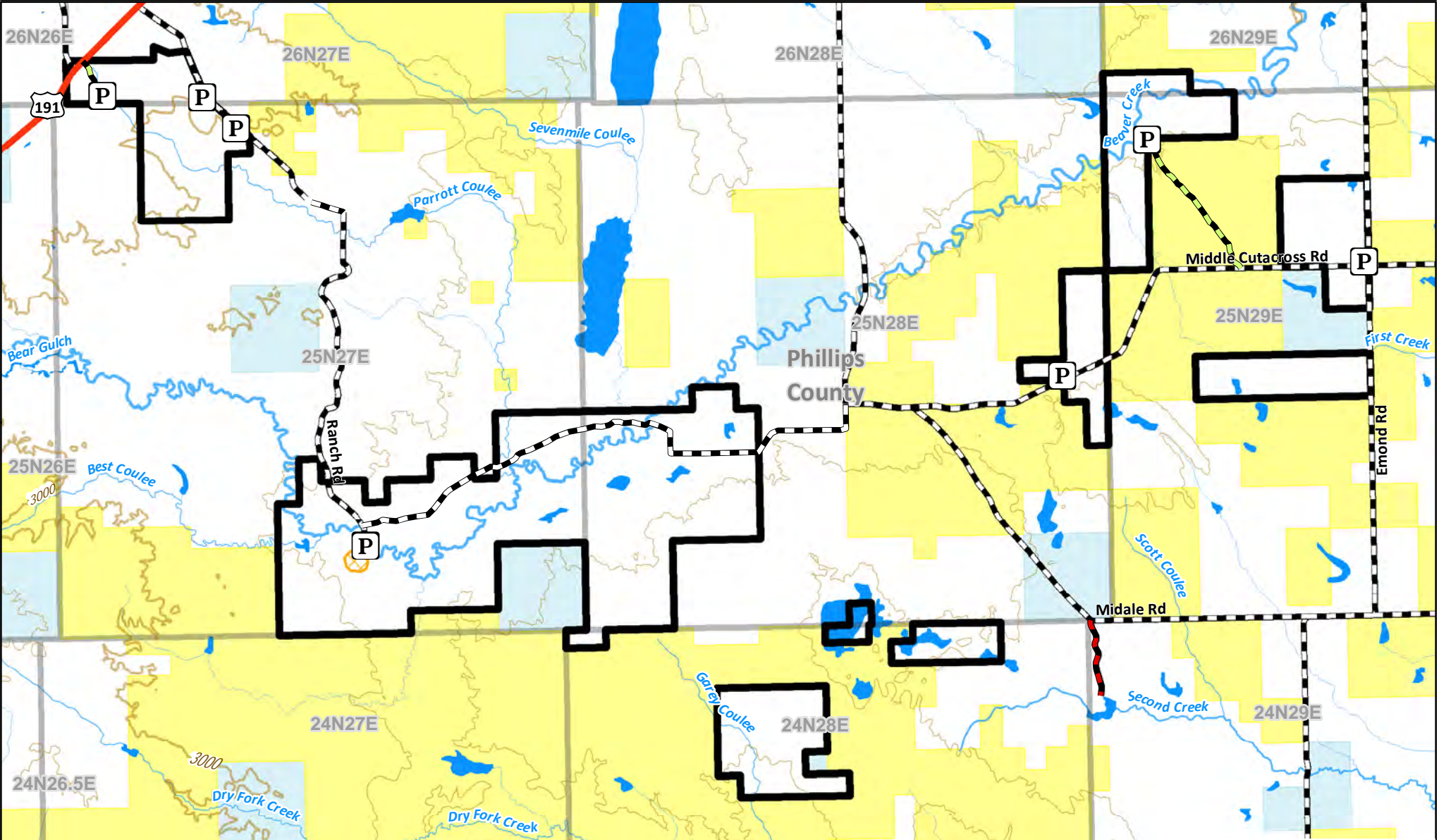


AP Dry Fork Block Management Area #43

GENERAL INFORMATION

AP Dry Fork BMA is in Phillips County south of Malta. AP Dry Fork BMA is 12,309 acres and contains a mix of CRP fields and native grass land and Beaver Creek running through majority of the property. This BMA has been enrolled since 2020.

Primary Hunting opportunities are Whitetail Deer, Mule Deer, Antelope, Sharptail Grouse, and Pheasants.

Restricted game: Sage Grouse & Elk

No shooting of non-game species/predators.

RESTRICTED SEASON

Landowner **does not** authorize use of this BMA for **Traditional Muzzleloader Season** in December.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Reservations cannot be made prior to August 22nd.

Reservations can be made by calling **(406)-422-6087** between **9:00 am and 12:00 pm Tuesday ONLY** before the Thursday - Monday you wish to hunt.

You must complete your reserved days before making another reservation.

Rest Days are Tuesdays and Wednesdays. 2 parties of 3 hunters per hunting day.

HOW TO GET THERE

From Malta:

34 miles southwest on Hwy 191 and then 12 miles SE on Ranch Rd.

BMA RULES

1. Motorized vehicle use is restricted to designated access routes, public roads and parking areas on BMA map or otherwise posted. All other motorized vehicle use is prohibited.
2. Use of all types of OHV, ATV's or similar vehicles are prohibited.
3. Do not park vehicles in such a manner as to obstruct traffic. **Do not block gates.**
4. Camping, littering, visible latrine pits, and fires are prohibited.
5. Hunters using horses and pack stock are required to use certified weed free hay 72 hours prior to entering BMA and while accessing BMA.
6. Commercial filming of hunts is prohibited.
7. Non-toxic lead is recommended.

STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

Block Management Area Rules do not apply to federal or DNRC lands that are legally accessible (via public roads, watercourses, or other legal means of access) unless specifically authorized by the applicable agency. Please, contact your local federal and state agencies for more information.

Access to this property for hunting is managed under Block Management Rules. Failure to abide by these BMA rules may result in eviction from this property and/or a citation maybe issued for failure to obtain landowner permission for hunting.

Access during all other times and for any other activity requires landowner permission.
