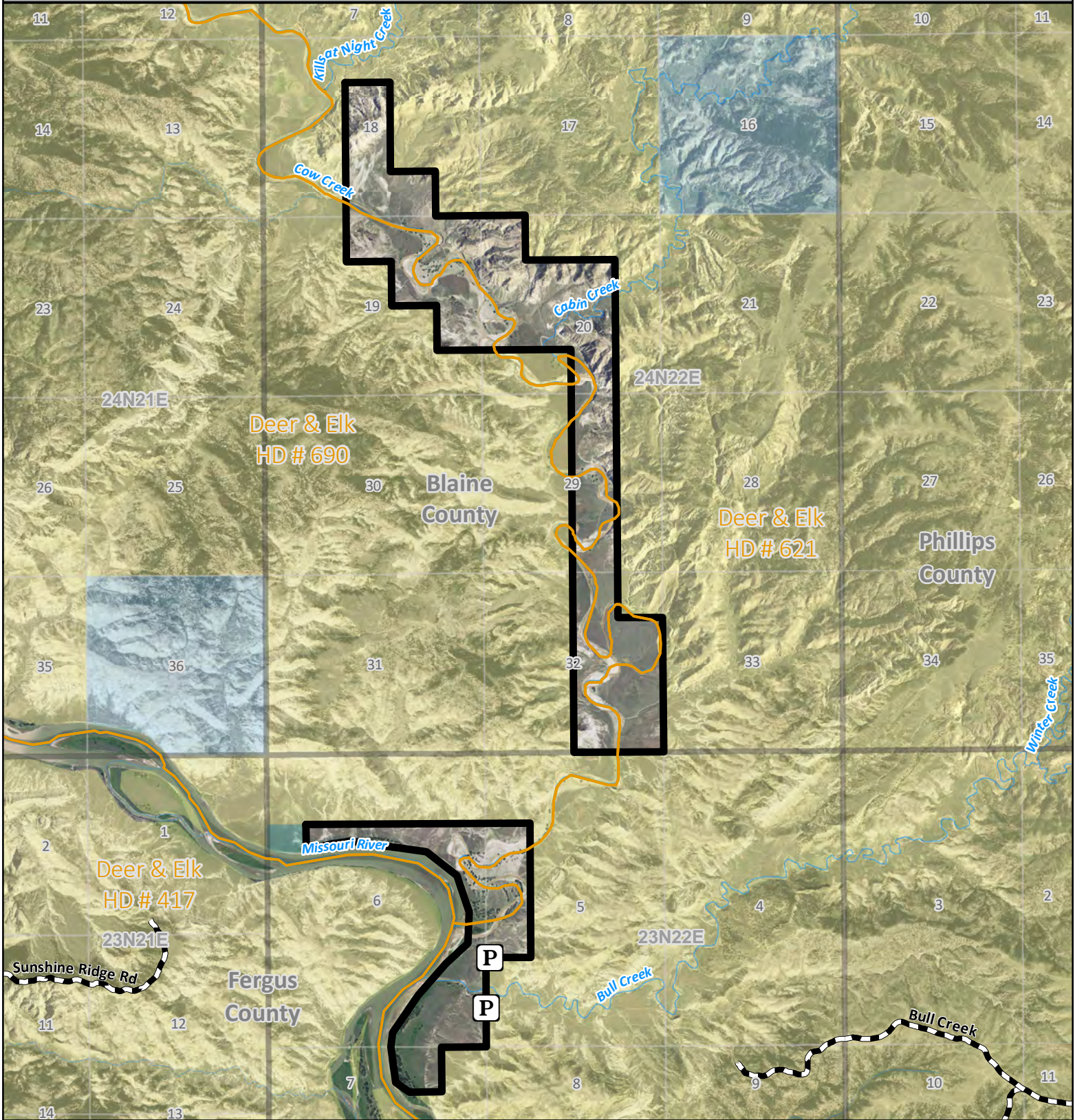

GENERAL INFORMATION

AP Cow Creek BMA is in Phillips County southwest of Landusky. AP Cow Creek BMA is 1,579 acres and contains native grassland, Missouri River breaks, and Cow Creek running through the property. This BMA has been enrolled since 2021.

Primary Hunting opportunities are Whitetail Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Antelope, and Upland Birds.

No shooting of non-game species/predators.

RESTRICTED SEASON

Landowner **does not** authorize use of this BMA for **Traditional Muzzleloader Season** in December.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

No permission is required to hunt this BMA. Please report your hunt to region6.access@mt.gov. Please report your dates hunted, number in your party, animals hunted, animals harvested, and your level of satisfaction.

Access is gained by boat from the Missouri River or from the Bull Creek Rd off Powerplant Ferry Rd.

HOW TO GET THERE

From Fred Robinson Bridge/James Kipp

Campground:

22 river miles northwest of the bridge.

From DY Junction:

1.8 miles north on Hwy 66, 12 miles southwest on Powerplant Ferry Rd, and 4 miles west on Bull Creek Rd. Road maybe impassible to vehicle use.

BMA RULES

1. Walk-in hunting only.
2. Use of all types of OHV, ATV's or similar vehicles are prohibited.
3. Camping, littering, visible latrine pits, and fires are prohibited.
4. Hunters using horses and pack stock are required to use certified weed free hay 72 hours prior to entering BMA and while accessing BMA.
5. Commercial filming of hunts is prohibited.
6. Non-toxic lead is recommended.

STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

Block Management Area Rules do not apply to federal or DNRC lands that are legally accessible (via public roads, watercourses, or other legal means of access) unless specifically authorized by the applicable agency. Please, contact your local federal and state agencies for more information.

Access to this property for hunting is managed under Block Management Rules. Failure to abide by these BMA rules may result in eviction from this property and/or a citation maybe issued for failure to obtain landowner permission for hunting.

Access during all other times and for any other activity requires landowner permission.
