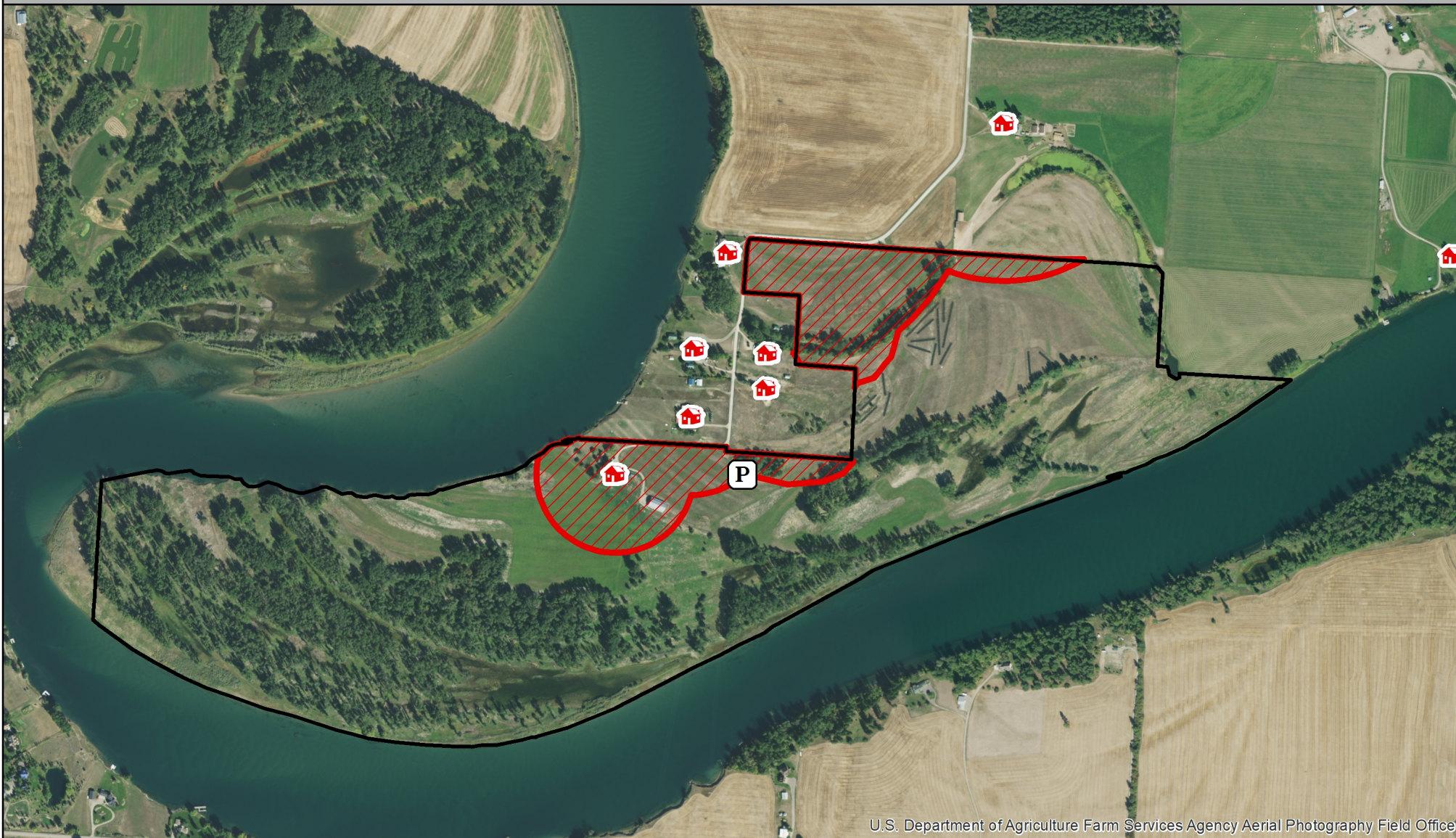

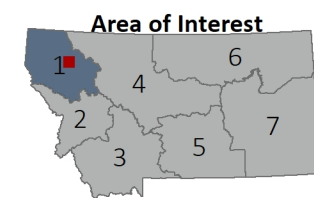

HUNTING USE RULES

Foys Bend Fisheries Conservation Area

Hunter numbers are restricted to one party of no more than four people per day. Hunters must make a reservation by calling 752-5501 or in person at FWP headquarters in Kalispell no more than a week in advance of the date they wish to hunt. Any one individual may access the property as a hunter or a party member only one day/week and not on consecutive days.

Public access is allowed Friday through Monday.

Firearms are restricted to shotgun, muzzleloader, or traditional handgun. No rifles are allowed. Except for this firearms restriction, all other current FWP regulations regarding weapons in hunting district 170 such as crossbows, archery equipment and non-toxic shot for waterfowl apply. Recreational shooting and hunting of nongame animals such as squirrels is prohibited.

No hunting within 200 yards of any building, including buildings on adjoining or nearby properties.

Hunting blinds must be removed or dismantled daily; no permanent blinds are allowed. Hunting blinds may not be constructed by cutting or otherwise damaging woody vegetation on the property.

No dogs allowed except for the purposes of hunting upland game or waterfowl during established seasons.

Vehicle parking only at designated parking areas. No motorized vehicles, bicycles, horses, or other livestock will be allowed on the property except for administrative or management purposes.

No overnight camping.

No campfires or fires of any kind.
