MPG RANCH – CHAPERONED HUNT DETAILS

The prize winner and a friend will go on a chaperoned hunt at the MPG Ranch south of Missoula. The MPG Ranch, in the Sapphire Mountains in the north Bitterroot Valley, has donated a chaperoned elk hunt as a prize for this year's Protect the Hunt raffle.

The winner of the prize can harvest a bull elk, antlerless elk, and either-sex white-tailed deer on the ranch, which is in hunting district 204. The winner can also bring a partner who is eligible to harvest an antlerless elk or white-tailed deer.

The hunt at the MPG Ranch will occur during 2027 general or late shoulder seasons. If the hunter is not successful in harvesting a bull elk during the general rifle season, they will have the opportunity to hunt antlerless elk during the 2027 late season.

Non-lead ammunition is a requirement for hunting on MPG Ranch. MPG will furnish ammunition and a suppressed rifle during this hunt.

Youth and adult hunters must be proficient with their personal firearm out to 350 yards. MPG Ranch rifles are highly accurate to 400 yards. Ranch staff will confirm proficiency with the ranch rifle at the ranch rifle range before the hunt.

MPG will work with the hunter to schedule additional days if necessary.

Winning hunters will need a general deer and elk license and/or 204-01 antlerless elk B licenses and/or a 299 deer B license. MPG Ranch staff will assist with field dressing and game retrieval.
