



## Corrections to the 2026 Printed Moose, Sheep, Goat, and Bison Regulations

Correction (page 36):

- A person may recover and possess the horn or horns and attached skull, or a portion thereof, of a mountain sheep that died of natural causes. A person may not possess these parts of a mountain sheep if the mountain sheep was purposefully or accidentally killed, captured, or taken, including being struck by a vehicle. Horns and skulls recovered must be reported to the department within ~~72~~ 48 hours and presented to the department for inspection and placement of a permanent pin in a horn within 10 days. The fee for the pin is \$25. Horns and skulls found in state parks may not be recovered or possessed.
