

LEGAL NOTICE
SPECIAL EITHER-SEX MULE DEER MANAGEMENT HUNT IN PORTION
OF H. D. 535



By order of the Montana Fish and Wildlife Commission, portions of Hunting District 535 shall be open to **archery hunting only** for either-sex mule deer by resident and nonresident holders of special either-sex mule deer management hunt licenses. A management hunt has been enacted for the area in and adjacent to the town of Roundup, Montana. The City of Roundup has requested either-sex mule deer B-licenses be made available up to two per hunter and valid from November 5, 2022 through February 15, 2023, to try and reduce the number of mule deer in and immediately adjacent to town. These Roundup Management b-licenses do not count towards an individual hunter's limit of B-licenses they may have in one year.

For this deer management hunt **archery** hunting is the only means of take due to safety concerns imposed by the proximity to residential areas and businesses. An additional 90 either-sex mule deer B-licenses (**Roundup Management Season License**) will be made available first-come first-served, limited to 2 per person. These licenses will be available starting at 5:00 AM, Wednesday, October 5, 2022 through the ALS system. A current Conservation License and Bow & Arrow license is also required.

From November 5, 2022 through February 15, 2023 the only valid license for this hunt will be the 2022 Roundup Management Season License.

The hunt area extends approximately 1 mile west; 1 mile east; 1 mile north and 1 mile south of Roundup MT and is on property owned by the City of Roundup and Musselshell County. The hunt area is legally defined as portions of T8N R25E Sections 11-13, 23, 24; T8N R26E Section 18. **Hunters need to obtain permission to hunt at the Roundup City offices (406-323-2804) from 8AM-5PM Monday thru Friday.** The Roundup City offices are located at 34 3rd Ave West. Maps detailing the hunt area and rules will be available at the Roundup City offices.
